More Pool Information

Skyview pool will not open until around the second week of June. Unfortunately our 40-year old pool is in need of major repairs. The Board is attempting to acquire a loan for these repairs. The Board is working very hard to make some much needed updates and repairs to the pool houses and bathrooms. Please be patient as there is a lot of work that needs to be done and very little funds. If you own or work for a company that is able to donate supplies and/or services please contact Rick Baechle or Matt Tomecko. A special thank you to ALL residents who came out for our first Community Volunteer Day on Saturday May 17th. We were able to replace fascia board, install and re-install gutters, and clean out the storage rooms. We will be painting, power washing and fixing up the bathrooms as well. Lifeguards and/or Swim Instructors

Swimming Lessons

Starfish Aquatic Institute

The Starfish Swim School curriculum consists of swim classes containing age-appropriate activities that focus on development of core swimming competencies and, once achieved, development of proper stroke technique. We recognize that all students learn in different ways and have different levels of readiness, which is why we focus on ability not disability and achievement not errors in our swim classes.

Swimming Lesson Schedule

Swim classes are taught in eight (8) 30-minute sessions, over a two-week period. Each color level focuses on one of the five core swimming competencies, which are designed to teach safety and survival skills, and are what we use to identify each student's level in our swim classes.

<u>Swimming Lesson Pricing</u>
We will offer two separate sessions over the summer season. **Each class is \$49 per child for Forest** Hills residents and \$54 per child for Non-Forest Hill residents.

The sessions are 4 days/week for 2 weeks. Lesson applicants will be contacted 1 week prior to the start of lessons with the lesson times. The first Monday of each session is registration day.

> The session dates are: Session I: June 16-27 Session II: July 7-18

2014 Pool Rules and Regulations

Pool Schedule (Weather Permitting):

Westchester: May 24 to Sept. 1 (Labor Day)

Hours*: May 24 - 26 = Noon - 8 pm May 27 - 28 = 4 pm - 8 pm

May 29 - August 17 = Noon - 8 pm

August 18 -Sept. 1 =(Weekdays 4 pm - 8 pm)

(Weekends/holiday Noon - 8 pm)

Skyview**: Middle of June (TBD) to Sept. 1 (Labor Day)

Hours*: TBD – August 17 = Noon – 8 pm

August 18 -Sept. 1 =(Weekdays 4 pm - 8 pm)

(Weekends/holiday Noon - 8 pm)

The pools may close due to inclement weather, which will be at the discretion of the pool management company. If the pool closes due to weather, residents are required to leave the pool area. Pool hours are subject to interruption due to swimming programs and/or when pool is rented out. Dates and times will be posted ahead of time at the designated pool. If the gate is locked and/or no guard is on duty, STAY OUT!

Use of Pool:

ANY Association Member that is NOT current with their association dues is not permitted to use the pool facilities OR be a guest of another association member! You can mail your past due payment to the association's P.O. box and once received your tags can be picked up. This process can take up to 10 days.

Guest Restrictions:

A member of the Association must accompany ALL guests. There are NO exceptions to this rule! Guests must be made aware of pool rules and association members will be accountable for their guest's actions. Members must register ALL of their guests in the sign in book available at each pool. Please limit the number of guests you bring per visit (10 to 14 year olds can bring 1 guest per visit, 15 to 17 year olds can bring 2 guests per visit, and adults may bring a reasonable number of guests per visit). Pool rental is available for a small fee if you wish to bring a large number of people. Lifeguards reserve the right to ask any guest(s) to leave if necessary.

Pool RULES:

Pool rules are for the safety and enjoyment of everyone! Please read and follow them:

- Your pool tag must be shown to the guard upon arrival to the pool. In addition we ask that you sign in when you enter as well. No one will be permitted to enter the pool area without a pool tag. Any staff and/or board member may ask to see your pool tag so keep it with you. Tags are issued when your assessment is paid. There is a small fee for replacement of tags so keep them in a safe place. There will be one tag per household.
- Guest(s) are permitted into pool area only with an association member.
- No running or horseplay will be tolerated in the pool or surrounding area.
- All swimmers must wear a standard swimsuit. NO cut-offs, sweatshirts, pants, Capri's, etc...
- Non-toilet trained children MUST wear swim diapers.

^{*}Please note that pool hours MAY shorten towards the middle of August as the nights become shorter and colder.

^{*}Due to much needed renovation on the Skyview Pool, it will not open until the middle of June. We will let you know as soon as we can when it will open.

- Acceptable toys that can be played with in the pool: squishy balls, noodles, face mask, goggles, snorkel, fins, dolls, water cans, dive toys or any plastic toy. Lifeguard has final decision and may restrict toys if they cause a safety hazard.
- Unacceptable toys in the pool: inner tubes, rafts, tennis balls, football or any other type of hard ball
- Water wings, tubes, noodles and lifejackets are permitted in the shallow end ONLY. An adult MUST accompany the child in the water and be next to the child using the safety floatation device.
- NO abusive language by children or adults will be tolerated. You will be asked to leave immediately.
- No one is permitted in the pump/furnace rooms.
- All swimmers will be given a deepwater test if there is any question of their swimming ability. This is at the discretion of the lifeguard on duty. Parents may NOT override the guard's decision.
- Parents of young children should keep a watchful eye on their own children. If they are playing
 on the steps at the Westchester pool, parents should be sitting with them. YOUR children are
 your responsibility!
- Children under the age of 10 years old will not be allowed in the pool unless accompanied by a
 parent or responsible caregiver between the ages of 12 to 17 years old. Parents should provide
 lifeguard with a note including children's names and contact number.
- NO glass containers are permitted in or around the pool area.
- NO alcoholic beverages are permitted in or around the pool area.
- No bikes, tricycles, scooters or skateboards are allowed in the pool area.
- No pets, balloons, string in a can or weapons of any kind are permitted in the pool area.

Safety Breaks: Safety breaks are every hour for 15 minutes. All children must clear the pool. Adults ONLY (18 years or older) may stay in the water during this time. Children 4 years and younger may stay in the pool WITH their parent(s).

Health Rules: Please do NOT swim if you have open sores, inflamed eye(s) or any other communicable disease, or diarrhea. If you have had diarrhea, please refrain from swimming for 2 weeks. This will help keep our pools free from Recreational Water Diseases. Remove all bandages before entering the pool.

Food/Smoking: Food and snacks are permitted in the pool area but please clean-up after yourself. Smoking is not permitted inside the fence and around the perimeter of the fence. Lets keep a clean, healthy environment for everyone to enjoy!

Pool Rental: To schedule a pool party, contact **Rachel Kotalik at** <u>rmkotalik@frontier.com</u>. You may rent the pool from 7:30 pm to 10:30 pm with two lifeguards. We ask that you schedule your event at least 2 to 3 weeks in advance so that we may post signs to inform residents of the change in hours. The price to rent the pool will be \$100 with a \$50 dollar deposit that will be put toward the rental price.

Tennis Courts: When using the tennis courts please have your pool tag with you. We ask that anyone under 12 years of age have an adult Association member with them. And please treat our net with kindness! NO sitting on or any other type of destructive behavior to the net or the tennis court area!

ALL rules and regulations are subject to change. Please keep a copy of these rules/regulations! The rules have been provided in the interest of health, safety and the enjoyment of our pool for all residents.
